The Certificate III in Aviation (Aerodrome Operations) is a nationally recognised qualification which meets the requirements of CASA AC139 for Aerodrome Reporting Officer training. The qualification teaches the competencies of an ARO, inspecting, reporting and managing aerodrome works for example, but moves beyond the skill set, and prepares you for a higher role—a supervisory position or team leader. You will learn additional skills such as emergency response, wildlife control and safety management.

IS THIS COURSE FOR ME?

This course is for those who want to work outdoors, airside, among the aircraft and the busy environment of an aerodrome inspecting and monitoring safety-critical facilities. You will learn theory and be required to follow strict rules and procedures as you apply theoretical concepts in the field. You will enjoy working in a structured manner in a highly regulated environment and enjoy solving issues as part of your daily duties.

There is one pre-requisite—you must have an Australian driver's licence.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

The objectives of this course are to prepare you for work as a senior ARO or team supervisor. Given an Australian aerodrome, aerodrome manual and associated technical instructions, procedures and reporting tools and equipment, perform the daily routine and non-routine duties of an aerodrome reporting officer in accordance with the requirements of CASR part 139 and the MOS 139.

COURSE DURATION

Taught over **six months**, with **two workshops** with three months of practical assessment between workshops.
