PROGRAMME INFORMATION

During our Diploma of Quality Auditing workshops you will learn how to: plan, organise, and conduct various types of quality and safety audits; evaluate solutions to unpredictable problems and identify, analyse and synthesise information from a variety of sources; plan and write a technical audit report and monitor your own workload and the workload of others. You will learn to use communication skills to support individuals and teams to meet organisational and regulatory requirements. You will learn good interview techniques and logical methods of measuring the safety, compliance and conformance of complex aviation systems. This is good stuff if you want to be an international aerospace auditor or consultant.

IS THIS COURSE FOR ME?

In aviation, the auditor is the crash investigator before the crash occurs. Aviation auditing is a safety-critical role, so the course is for people interested in actively preventing accidents. Auditing skills are extremely useful for people who want to work as safety professionals, investigators, regulators, international consultants or managers who are required to ensure their operation is compliant. Auditing requires patience, emotional intelligence and logical thinking. It can be hard work questioning your colleagues, working alone, searching for latent conditions that could cause an accident, but you will be part of the safety team; you will make a difference.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

The objective of our Diploma of Quality Auditing is to teach you to apply quality auditing knowledge and skills in the aviation industry across a broad range of departments, audit criteria and audit programmes.

Given a variety of aviation workplace and audit scenarios, you are asked to; demonstrate your ability to plan, organise and conduct an audit; manage an audit team; plan and write a technical report; and, follow-up audit findings until the audit is closed, using defined audit principles and methods as described in international audit standards ISO19011 and ISO9001.

COURSE DURATION

There are two ways you can complete the Diploma of Quality Auditing with ASSET Aviation Institute:

Intensive study: Includes ten consecutive days of training over two weeks.

Intensive Study + On-the-Job-Training: 1 month

- Safety department officer or investigator with 7 years of operational experience
- Aerodrome quality assurance or safety assurance officer with 7 years of operational experience
- Ground handling quality assurance or safety assurance with 7 years of operational experience.
